Dear Parents,

**Year 6** will have P.E on **Thursdays** and **Fridays** starting as from Thursday 3rd September.

Due to new COVID regulations, we will not be asking children in Upper Primary to change from their school uniform into their P.E. kit. Therefore, on their P.E days, children will be asked to come to school wearing their P.E. kit. There will be no need to change back into their school uniform that day. We will inform you if there are any changes to this policy.

At Loreto we traditionally start the term with swimming lessons for Upper Primary. However, due to Government restrictions at GASA Swimming pool, there will be no swimming lessons for the foreseeable future. Therefore, both P.E. lessons will require children to come to school wearing their normal P.E kit.

May I take this opportunity to remind you of the correct P.E attire:

- White school P.E T-shirt (available from the school office for £10.00)
- Plain white shorts (**Boys**) / Black cycling shorts (**Girls**)
- White socks and white trainers
- School tracksuit may be worn during winter months

Please label all children's clothing, especially shoes and jumpers and please ensure your child **does not** wear any jewellery (including small stud earrings and watches) on the day they have P.E in order to avoid injury to themselves and others. If your child is wearing jewellery on their P.E day, it may result in them being unable to participate in the lesson.

Should your child be required to miss the P.E lesson due to medical reasons, please ensure you send a note explaining the reason.

Class teachers will remind all children to take their water bottles to P.E. with them and they will have the opportunity to refill them if needed. If your child is asthmatic, please ensure their inhaler is brought with them to every P.E. lesson.
