UNIFORM POLICY

This policy reflects the ethos of Loreto Convent School and has been compiled and reviewed with the involvement of children, staff and Governors.

The uniform at Loreto Convent School is a symbol of your aspiration to excellence and high achievement. Your appearance is a measure of your self-discipline. It reflects your pride and commitment to being a member of the school, and is a visible sign of your readiness to learn.

Uniform Expectations

Our vision is for outstanding learning, achievement and behaviour for all children. Our uniform is a means of expressing this level of expectation and a way for the children to express their pride in themselves and their school. We expect all children to wear their uniform correctly and with pride.

We expect the children to wear their uniform correctly and smartly at all times, including when they are travelling to and from school.

Red and white striped dress with school logo on pocket

White school polo shirt

Winter Uniform - Girls

White collared shirt

Grey school cardigan with logo and red stripes on sleeves

Grey kilt skirt

Grey knee length socks or grey / red tights

Black school shoes

Red school jacket

Summer Uniform – Boys

White school polo shirt with crest
Dark grey shorts
Grey socks
Black school shoes

Winter Uniform – Boys

White collared shirt
School tie
Grey school V-neck jumper with logo and red stripes on sleeves
Grey trousers
Grey socks
Black school shoes
Red school jacket

PE Kit

Lower Primary School and Y3 & Y4

White school PE shirt
White shorts (Boys and FS1-Y2 School girls)
Black cycling shorts (Y3-Y4 girls)
White socks
White trainers
School tracksuit

Upper Primary School – Years 5 & 6

White school PE shirt
Black shorts with Loreto crest (Boys)
Black skort with Loreto crest (Girls)
White socks
White trainers
Grey and red school tracksuit with Loreto Crest
For swimming, children must wear the School swimming costume and House colour swimming cap

Nursery Uniform

Nursery pupils may wear the full school uniform, the school grey tracksuit or similar grey tracksuit with a white polo or T shirt underneath in winter. During the summer months, girls may wear the red and white stripey dress (or similar) and boys grey shorts and white school t-shirt / polo (or similar).

Please ensure all items are clearly named – preferably with printed / woven nametapes.

NOTES: No jewellery other than stud earrings and watches should be worn at any time. No jewellery to be worn on PE days.
